

## Registration:

- Prerequisites:

To participate in this tournament, all participants need a valid A-License from the DTFB or an equivalent license from their national table football association. In addition, an ITSF license is required, which must be paid in CORAL before the start of the tournament.

The ITSF dress code applies, with the exception that in doubles, both partners must wear matching jerseys.



Play is conducted according to ITSF rules. Referees are compensated at €2 per set/team.



The total number of doubles entries is limited to 240. Singles entries are limited to 300.



The organization fee is €15 for participation on one match day. For participation on both match days, the organization fee is €25 in total.

## DTFB Regulations / Anti-Doping Notice

### Smoking Ban

There is an absolute smoking and vaping ban for players and spectators in the tournament area. Violations will be penalized according to §11 (10) of the Fee Schedule (Go).

### Open Beverages

In the area around the playing tables, beverages may only be carried in resealable containers. This applies to players and spectators. Violations will be penalized according to §11 (10) of the Fee Schedule (Go).

### Cleanliness

All waste must be disposed of in designated containers. Leaving waste on the floor or on any surfaces not designated for waste is prohibited. Violations will be penalized according to §11 (14) of the Fee Schedule (Go).

### Alcohol

In the area around the playing tables, there is an absolute alcohol ban for active players in sportswear during competition times. Violations will be penalized according to §11 (15) of the Fee Schedule (Go).

### Anti-Doping

Anti-doping tests will be conducted during the tournament in accordance with the Anti-Doping Regulations. By participating in the tournament, all players commit to cooperation.


